

Literacy

Writing - we practice writing across the curriculum and have a specific writing session on Thursday mornings. This term we'll focus on composing our own sentences including capital letters, finger spaces and full stops.

Reading - every day we have a phonics lesson and I aim to hear each child read once every week.

Handwriting - we are learning to write all the letters correctly. We practise in the morning before and during the register.

Library - We visit the library on Tuesdays so bring your book and you can swap it for a new one.
