

## ST BARNABAS PRIMARY SCHOOL HOME/BLENDED LEARNING PLAN

This policy has been written after discussions with staff and in response to feedback from families following the partial closure of schools during the Covid-19 pandemic from March to July.

Since September 2020 children in school have been organised in class bubbles working with a restricted number of adults. In the event of complete or partial closure of a bubble, we will provide continuity in learning, maintain connection with teachers and classmates and will monitor children's engagement and progress through the use of online learning platforms.

Our first priority will always be to ensure children's **safety** and **wellbeing whether in school or at home**. We recognise that each family has different circumstances and that we will need to respond in a way which is right for them. Whenever possible school will loan a chrome book/laptop, paper, pens, reading books including class books to children who do not have equipment at home.

<p><b><u>If a child's bubble or part bubble at school are isolating for 14 days or in the event of a local lockdown</u></b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Reception-Year 1 - teachers will send a daily email outlining learning activities.</li> <li>• Year 2 – learning pack for English, Google classroom for Maths (Teachers will set daily tasks and give feedback via Google classroom - parents/children will complete tasks online and upload additional evidence such as photos)</li> <li>• Year 3-6 daily Maths and English lessons via Google Classroom (Children will complete tasks, participate in chats and attend Google Meets)</li> </ul>

**In the event of a whole school closing, the Children learning at home will be kept in contact via a daily Google meet.**

Depending on the age of the children this may be a story, a chat, an introduction to a subject or a PPT and will be at different times to other classes.
