Our School motto and rules

Positive behaviour

We reward and focus on positive behaviour with praise, stickers, house points and entry in the Silver and Gold Books.

Negative behaviour and breaking school rules

For making the wrong choices and ignoring school rules (shouting out, not following instructions, not getting on with work or general messing about) two warnings are issued before a consequence is given. Consequence will take place in the classroom.

If the behaviour continues, two more warnings are given and then the child is to go to the paired classroom for the remainder of the session.

Work or an activity must be sent with the child.

If this happens the class teacher will email parents.

If the behaviour continues on return, the child is sent to Mrs Donaghey

Very poor behaviour and breaking school rules.

Serious breach of the school rules

Swearing, hitting, fighting, rudeness and serious defiance the child is to be

sent directly to Mrs Donaghey

If this happens, Mrs Donaghey will phone and/or meet with the child's parent(s)

Racist or homophobic incidents will be recorded.
