- Reinforce everything from Term 2

Music, Art, Design & Technology

For **music** this term we are learning songs that link to our science and geography topics. We are also going to listen to 'The Carnival of the Animals' by Camille Saint-Saëns. In **art** we are going to make craft Paddington Bears. In **D&T** we are going to be learning about nutrition and preparing foods ready for a Teddy Bear picnic. This will celebrate Paddington's birthday. We will also be learning about weaving and textiles by designing and making an aquarium that has fabric fish and sea creatures.

Computing

This term we will continue to complete programming challenges using Beebots! We will then have an introduction into animation.

Mathematics

This term we are learning to partition two-digit numbers, find fact families, find half of a group of objects, draw and make equal groups as well as solving division problems.

We will continue to learn about amounts of distance, mass, money, space, temperature and time. We will apply our counting skills to reason and problem solve alongside one another in the indoor and outdoor provision. We will also focus on counting in multiples of 10s, 5s and 2s.

At the end of this term we will start to learn about fractions and representing data.

Topic

Each half term we have two topics.

PADDINGTON BEAR

Geography

We are using the Paddington story books to find out about where Paddington is from. We will compare Machu Picchu with London and Jericho. We will also find out about the continents and oceans, along with the countries in the UK.

Science - Animals including humans part 1

We will use the stories 'Grow: Secrets of Our DNA' and 'Lots: The Diversity of Life on Earth' by Nicola Davies to study the five groups of vertebrates.

UNDER THE SEA

Geography

We are going to use 'Tiddler' by Julia Donaldson to study the five oceans and underwater kelp forests found in the seas of the UK.

Science - Animals including humans part 2

We will use 'The Story Orchestra: Carnival of the Animals' to explore our senses.

Religious Education (RE)

This term we are learning about Christianity, Judaism and Islam. We will be exploring the questions 'Are some stories more important than others?' and 'Do we need shared special places?'
