Personal, Social, Health, and Economic education (PSHE)

The two topics for this term are

- 'Healthy me
- 'Changing Me' (changing body and human anatomy)

Topic: Sensational Safari and Let's visit Australia

History/ Geography -

Sensational Safari. We will use the story Handa's surprise to learn about Kenya and Africa. Children will learn about the key Geographical features of the country including Kenyan wildlife, landscapes and culture and will make comparisons between Kenya and the UK.

Let's Visit Australia We will learn about Australia's continent and culture and will make comparisons between Australia and the UK.

D.T. and Art -

We will design, create and decorate tribal masks. We will learn about Australian aboriginal art and create pictures using natural colors, patterns and dots. We will also be learning about weaving and textiles by designing and making a panda bag.

I.C.T. - We will be investigating and using ICT to research. We will do some programming challenges using Beebots.

Science-

Living things and their habitats. We will learn about a variety of habitats and the plants and animals that live there. We will be making observations of our local habitat and the creatures that live there, investigating microhabitats and minibeasts found within them. We will learn how to describe how animals obtain their food from plants and other animals, using the idea of a simple food chain.

Music

This term we will be singing in the whole school singing assembly. We will be learning a selection of different songs and focusing on rhythm and timing.
